The Barre Social is an events and coworking space, retail shop and brunch spot in downtown Barre City.

We offer coworking memberships designed for remote workers, entrepreneurs, side-hustlers or anyone who needs to get out during the typical weekday workday.

Social memberships are designed for those who don't have or need the flexibility of a coworking membership, but want to relax or socialize after work and on weekends. Are you an educator? We have a special social membership option for you.

All memberships include access to the space during designated business hours, plus after-hours member events, free beverages from the kitchen, conference room time and guest passes. Members also receive discounts on space rentals, brunch, in the retail shop, and even other participating Barre businesses.

Memberships are vital to the longterm health of the club, but you don't have to be a member to enjoy or support it. Day passes, conference room and event space rentals are available for nonmembers as well. We also host occasional public and ticketed special events.

Our retail shop is open to the public and features a variety of items from more than two dozen Vermont-based artists, makers and companies.

You'll find our own merch, including hats, sweatshirts & t-shirts, plus well-known brands like Farmhouse Pottery, Ursa Major, Queen City Footwear and Maple Landmark. We even have locally-made items produced by our members, including Tilia Tea Co. and Mama Tree Farm.
